VILLAGE PULIGNY-MONTRACHET

GEOGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

Puligny is located between Meursault and Chassagne-Montrachet in south of Beaune. This appellation is house to some well-known Grands Crus: Montrachet, Chevalier-Montrachet, Bâtard-Montrachet, Bienvenues-Bâtard-Montrachet. It is a village of Gallo-Roman origin. At the end of the 12th century the monks planted the first vines on the hamlet of Blagny. It was 1879 that Puligny added to his name, that of his most famous Grand Cru: Montrachet.
